AMENDMENTS TO VOTING REGISTER

Methodology

Although the correct methodology has been applied in calculating voting entitlements, the description of this on the front page of the voting register was inaccurate in one respect. The section dealing with votes in respect of Game Fee/Deemed Game Fee should have referred to the number of half results divided by 1,000 being rounded up rather than rounded down to the nearest whole number.
