The Aim:

To create school chess clubs and inter-school chess tournaments.

The Reason:

To encourage children to play brain-games and to promote strategic-thinking, logic and concentration in our country's youth.

Who benefits?

Children:

By providing a thought-provoking activity that is both fun and challenging, in school and out.

Why get involved?

We would like to set up a meeting to discuss whether you would be interested in participating by providing a financial donation or a donation in kind.

Who benefits from your help?

- Schools: By providing a national activity in which schools can involve and motivate their students.
- School-children and society: By having something with a positive social dimension to do both during and out of school hours, children from all walks of life are offered an outlet for their competitive drive.
- **Sponsors:** Being associated with *Chess for Schools* will positively influence your reputation, drawing the approbation of shareholders, customers, government and all those interested in your company.
- The environment: Recycling plastic for a projected total of 250,000 sets means that over 100 tonnes of
 material will be reused. Thus promoting the benefits of recycling to those people whose future behaviour is so
 important to the environment.
- Our employees: Many of our employees are parents who will hear about the initiative from their children and through Holloid itself. We hope this will engender a sense of pride at working for a company whose corporate responsibility programme is actively seeking to make a difference.
