Charitable Status survey

Introduction

One theme that came to our attention from the consultation was an encouragement for the ECF Board to seek views of the membership on certain issues in a survey .

Background

Moving to charitable status would be a major change for the ECF and would require a certain amount of reorganisation (as the papers have previously explained).

One of the major reorganisational aspects of a move to charitable status would be the required split between charitable and non-charitable activities. The specific implications for the ECF are that the non-amateur chess activities included within International Chess and the British Championships would need to be excluded from the charity.

Responses

The survey was hosted on the ECF's website featuring as the top item throughout the month of July. 51 responses were received and are summarised in the following pie charts.
