ENGLISH CHESS FEDERATION FINANCE COUNCIL MEETING 18 APRIL 2015 PROPOSED CHANGES TO BYELAW NO. 3 THE PROCEDURAL BYELAWS

The following changes to the Byelaw are proposed:

- 1. Paragraph 5.2
- (a) the period for the Board to consider the minutes of Council meetings is reduced from 10 to 4 weeks.
- (b) the Minutes shall be published on the ECF Web Site within 6 weeks of the closure of the Meeting instead of 13 weeks.

The rationale is to improve governance by doing things quicker.

- 2. Paragraph 12.3 Reference to advertising Posts in ChessMoves to be deleted. This no longer seems relevant.
- 3. Paragraph 12.8:
 - (a) The electoral address to be limited to 750 words instead of one page.
 - (b) The following sentence to be added to the end of the paragraph: "Electoral addresses received before the deadline for applications shall be published simultaneously on the website after the deadline has closed. Electoral addresses received after the deadline shall not be published. "
 - "a" is in response to difficulties in previous elections.
 - "b" is in response to the complaints raised and associated action at the October 2014 Council meeting.
- 4. New Paragraph 12.8.1: The following to be included: "Candidates are required to comply with the Code of Conduct (Regulation No. 4) during the election campaign period. "
 The Code of Conduct is imposed on ECF officials through Regulation No. 4. The amendment is intended to ensure equable conditions for elections between incumbents and new candidates.
