## RULES:

- All tournaments will be five rounds Swiss and all entrants will be expected to play each round. Players may claim a half-point bye for any one round at the time of entry.
- The ECF Jan 2017 list will be the primary source for determining eligibility for grade-restricted sections. However, the organisers reserve the right to use other printed grading lists where deemed appropriate. Players entering before the Jan 2017 list is published will be moved up a section(s) if their Jan 2017 ECF grade is above the upper limit for the section they originally entered.
- Ungraded players must give an indication of their playing strength where possible at the time of entry (e.g. recent congress results). Organisers reserve the right to transfer any entrant from one tournament to another. The event is ECF game fee registered and results will be submitted for grading purposes.
- Ungraded players will not be eligible for grading prizes unless they provide acceptable evidence of their playing strength.
- *Phones are allowed in the venue but must be switched off during play.* Penalties for phones sounding, up to loss of the game, will be determined by controllers, according to circumstances. No smoking is allowed inside the school building or in the grounds.
- In all matters the organisers' decision is final. The organisers exercise their right to reduce the prize fund in the event of insufficient entries.

## RATE OF PLAY

42 moves in 1 hour and 45 minutes. After Black's 42<sup>nd</sup> move both clocks are turned back 15 minutes and the game completed in the time then available.
