**FIDE OPEN:** Open to all players with a FIDE ID and national federation. Entry fee £37 (before junior and member discounts - see over for details)

1st Prize: £250; 2nd Prize: £150; 3rd Prize: £75; Grading prize<sup>3</sup> £50

FIDE MAJOR: Open to all players with a FIDE ID and national federation,

rated U1900 or U160 ECF if no Elo-rating

Entry fee £37 (before junior and member discounts - see over for details)

1st Prize: £250; 2nd Prize: £150; 3rd Prize: £75; Grading prize<sup>3</sup> £50

MINOR: For players graded under 120 (ECF) / 1600

**Grade/Rating:** ECF and WCU January 2018 published lists shall be used, along with the latest available FIDE list.

**Open and Major:** FIDE rating will take precedence, then ECF A or B category grade, then Welsh or other national Elo grade, then other category ECF grade.

*Minor*: ECF A or B category grade will take precedence, then Welsh or other national Elo grade, then FIDE rating and only then other category ECF grade.

The conversion formula used for the Minor where needed will be:

[(Welsh, or other Elo, or FIDE) - 700] ÷7.5 = ECF-equivalent grade and for the Open and Major will be the reverse, i.e.:

 $[(ECF \times 7.5) + 700] = FIDE$ -equivalent rating
