Prizegiving will take place as soon as possible after the end of round 5. Players may request a half-point bye in any one of the first three rounds at the time of entry.

Rate of Play

36 moves in 90 minutes, plus 15 minutes per person Quick-play.

Late Arrival

Players arriving more than 30 minutes after the scheduled start of any round will be recorded as a loss by default, unless a suitable pairing can be arranged. Players whose opponents have not arrived 30 minutes after the start of a round, and players having a bye, will be re-paired if possible.

Organisation

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or transfer an entry to another section without giving a reason. Players accept as a condition of entry that the Organisers' and Controller's decision on any aspect of the congress is final, and that the information provided on the entry form may be recorded and used for congress administration, mailing lists and grading purposes. Under exceptional circumstances, at the organisers' discretion, prize fund can be reduced. Adverse weather conditions may force either cancellation of the congress, or your withdrawal from it. While we can make no guarantee, we will try to refund at least part of the entry fee.
