VENUE AND DIRECTIONS

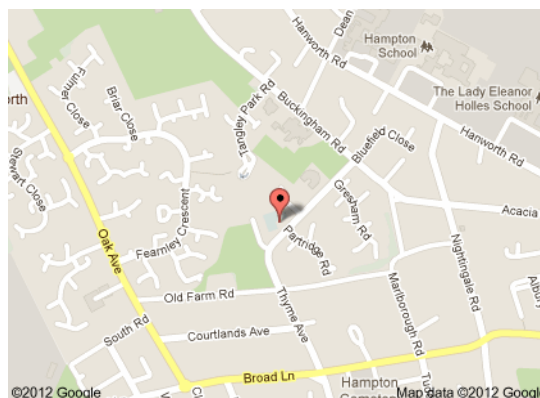
The White House Community Association is situated adjacent to Sainsbury's on The Avenue, in the Nurserylands area of Hampton.

Below are directions in brief. For detailed directions and a map, please see <http://www.surreyrapidchess.org/venue.html>.

By car. Heading along the A308 from Hampton Court towards Sunbury, turn right into Percy Road which leads into The Avenue. The venue is on the left as you come out of a right hand bend. There is ample on-site parking.

By rail to Hampton Station and then by foot (for just short of a mile) along Percy Road which leads into The Avenue, or by 111 bus.

By underground, either take the Piccadilly Line to Hounslow East and then the 111 bus, or take the District Line to Richmond (less frequent) and then the R70 bus. The 111 bus (from Heathrow, Hounslow and Kingston) and the R70 bus (from Richmond and Twickenham) both stop outside the venue.

LATE ARRIVAL

Any Player arriving more than 15 minutes late for the 1st round (and 10 mins for subsequent rounds) will be defaulted and their opponent will be re-paired if possible.

GRADING

All results will be submitted to the ECF for grading. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their grading information being published on the ECF website.

Rapidplay grades will be used where possible. Standard play grades will be accepted as the playing strength if a player has no rapidplay grade.

Players with estimated grades are not eligible to win a grading prize.

(Foreigners): FIDE ratings will be converted at the standard rate of (ELO-650 divided by 8).

REFRESHMENTS

A café with a selection of hot and cold food and drinks will be in operation.

The Organisers accept no responsibility for any loss, theft or accident during the tournament. Adult supervision for children taking part in the tournament will only be provided in the chess playing areas. Parents or guardians are responsible for their children during the tournament.
