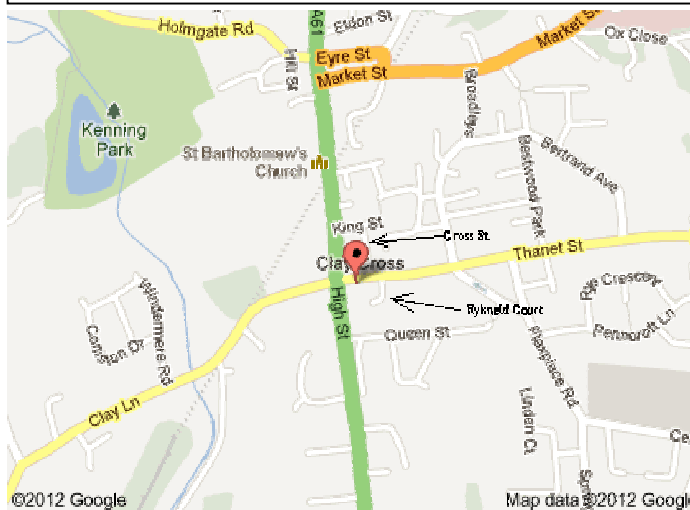

from **Sheffield & District** and **Derbyshire**
Chess Association Leagues.

From 4th August remaining places will be open
to all.

Cuthbert Redhead (1964 –2012)

While still a schoolboy, Cuthbert was one of
Clay Cross Chess Club's first members, and
he remained associated with the club ever
since.

We will always remember him for his calm
determination, gentle sense of justice and
pervasive humour. He struggled stoically and
uncomplaining with the debilitating effects
of Sickle Cell Anaemia all his life, and
tragically died in hospital this spring while
receiving treatment for his condition.
10% of Entry Fees will be donated to The
Sickle Cell Society.

Byes

A half point bye can be taken in rounds one to four.

Defaults

A player who has not appeared after 10 minutes into a round will be defaulted and their opponent re-paired if possible at quicker rate of play.

Disputes

The Tournament Controller's decision shall be final. FIDE Rules will be posted at venue.

Prize Giving

Prizes will be presented as soon as possible at the end of the last round.

FIDE rules will apply, and will be posted at the event.

PRIZES AND MONEY

The Venue is free – thanks to Craig the Manager! Equipment will be provided free – many thanks to Andy Butterworth at Chess Direct!

So administration costs will be very low. After deduction of the Sickle Cell Society donation and administration costs the Net Income from Entry Fees will be divided thus:

1st at least **25%** of Net Income

2nd at least **15%** of Net Income

3rd at least **10%** of Net Income

At least 5 Grading Prizes

distributed across the grading range, details to be announced BEFORE the start of Round 1. The Grading Prizes will share at least: **30%** of Net Income.

GRADES (or Ratings)

**For the purpose of determining the pairings and the allocation of grading prizes, one of the following values, given here in descending order of priority, will be used:
The player's:**

Current ECF Rapidplay grade on 1st Aug 2012

Current ECF Standardplay grade on 1st Aug 2012

Most recent ECF Rapidplay or Standardplay grade.

Most recent YCF Rapidplay or Standardplay grade.

An ungraded entrant MAY, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANISERS, be eligible for grading prize if and only if they offer adequate evidence of their current playing ability BEFORE Monday 13th Aug 2012

Grading

The organizers will forward all results to the Yorkshire grader.

(ECF game fee scheme: Results will not automatically be submitted to ECF for grading. However, **on request**, any of a player's results will be submitted if in any game:
A: both players are ECF members : **FREE**
B: only one player is an ECF member: On receipt by the Tournament Bursar of **30p per game**
C: neither player is an ECF member: On receipt by the Tournament Bursar of **60p per game**)
