SECTIONS

Under 12, Under 10 and Under 8, You must have been younger than the section age on 31st August 2012, so Under 12 means Year 7 or younger, Under 10 means Year 5 or younger and Under 8 means Year 3 or younger. You are allowed to enter older age groups if you wish. The organisers reserve the right to merge sections where the number of entries makes it impractical to run them separately.

TOURNAMENT DETAILS

Swiss pairings will be used. This is not a knockout tournament. All competitors play in every round. The organisers reserve the right to merge sections in the event of a section receiving insufficient entries.

Chess clocks will be used but help will be given to those who are not used to them. Each player will be allowed 30 minutes per game (making a maximum possible time for each game of 1 hour). ECF Rapidplay rules will be used.

Results will be sent for grading. The ECF publishes the Grading list on their website. If you wish to have your Grading details (Grading Reference Number, Name, Club(s), Grade(s), Grading Category) withheld from the website version please contact the ECF, www.englishchess.org.uk.

Parents and friends are welcome to stay, but should note that only stewards and players will be allowed in the playing areas. We do not provide any supervision of children between rounds so you must stay to look after your own children or arrange for another adult to be responsible for your children.

Under 10 Minor - 3.5/ 6 (Final 15, 16 Dec)

Under 10 Major - 4.5/ 6 (Final 15, 16 Dec)

Under 12 Minor - 3.5/ 6 (Final, 28-30 Dec)

Under 12 Major - 4.5/ 6 (Final 28-30 Dec)
