

CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS OF THE MIDDLESEX HUNDREDS 2012 (autumn)

A QUALIFYING EVENT FOR THE LONDON JUNIOR CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS

This tournament is open to chess players in the county of Middlesex and beyond. Full Championship titles can only be won by players who either, (a) live in the County of Middlesex or (b) go to school in the County of Middlesex. We are using the county boundaries as they were in 1965 (and prior to that), stretching back at least as far as the Domesday Book of 1086. From the map overleaf it can be seen that parts of Barnet are in Hertfordshire, Potters Bar and South Mimms are in Middlesex, as is the southern borough of Spelthorne.

VENUE: Isleworth & Syon School, Ridgeway Road, Isleworth, Middx, TW7 5LJ Date: SATURDAY, 3rd November, 2012, 10am – 5.50pm

Sections: U8, U10, U12, U14, U18 and Adult Novice Ages will be calculated as at 01/09/2012. Scoring will be 1 point for a win, 0.5 for a draw and 0 for a loss.

This event is suitable for children new to tournaments chess as well as for those who have more playing experience. Also parents and guardians welcome to test your strength in Adult Novice section. Clocks will be used on all sections, with 30 minutes for each player. Help will be given to anyone who has not used clock before.

All results will be submitted to the ECF for grading. The organisers reserve the right to merge sections where numbers are not viable.

There will be 6 Championship Titles to be won for each separate age group (U8, U10, U12, U14, U18 and Adult) plus individual titles for the Champion of each Hundred within the age groups. The Hundreds are Ossulstone, Edmonton, Gore, Hounslow, Elthorne and Spelthorne. Trophies will be awarded to section champions and certificates to Hundred Champions. In addition, players scoring 3.5 points or more will win a prize rosette or medal. Players from outside the county who win a section will be awarded a special trophy.
