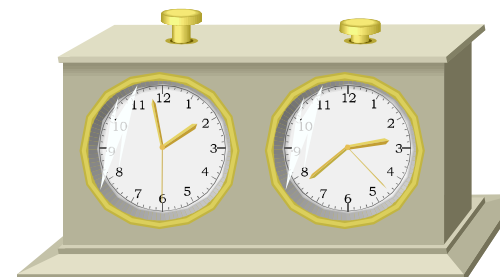

Separate and additional discount of £5 for Juniors (Players under 18 on 01/09/2012).

Grading prizes are payable only to entrants having a published grade. Any ungraded player may not win more than the value of the 3rd prize, except in the open tournament.

Late entries (postmarked after 15th February 2013) will be accepted at the organisers' discretion and will cost £4 extra.

TEAM PRIZE

There will be a team prize for the best total score by a genuine club or league team of four players who may compete in any section — please hand in team list on Friday evening by 8 p.m. Players may enter in ONE team only.

All prizes are subject to the number of entries. The Committee reserve the right to transfer an entrant to another section, or to refuse entry without giving a reason. The decisions of the Committee and Controllers are final.

All prizes are sent by post. Only one prize per player. All games will be forwarded for grading. It is a condition of entry that players agree that their details may be used for grading and mailing purposes.

Food and drink may not be brought into the Exeter Corn Exchange for consumption on the premises.
