**Scoring:** 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw, 1 point for a loss

**Entry fee:** £18, ECF Members £15, Additional family members £12, Late entry £5, (after Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2013).

**Prize:** There will be a Trophy for the winner of each of the 7 sections (age groups) and, in addition, within each section there will be a Championship Title to be won (a small prize) for the top player from each of the 6 areas of Middlesex, ie top player of **Ossulstone, Edmonton, Gore, Hounslow, Elthorne and Spelthorne**. That makes 7 Absolute Champions + 6 x 7 Hundreds Champions = 49 **Champions!!!** Hundreds (areas) will be decided on residence first, then on location or school or chess club. If you are unsure which hundreds you live in, please leave it blank and I will complete it. Plus Rosettes for players scoring 11 points or more.

**Qualifying Score for the MEGA Finals:** All section winners will qualify. 17 or more points up to U11 sections, 15 points or more for older sections,

**NOTES:** PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A KNOCK OUT TOURNAMENT. ALL 7 ROUNDS WILL BE PLAYED. Players living outside the county are invited to take part. They can win prizes, rosettes and qualify, but not win Hundreds title. If they win a section they will receive a replica Trophy. Ages will be calculated as at 01.09.2012

**PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU GET YOUR AGE AND DATE OF BIRTH ACCURATE ON THE ENTRY FORM SO YOU CAN GET INTO THE CORRECT SECTION.** Remember that ages are calculated as at midnight on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2012.

**Please note parents and guardians are responsible for your child throughout the day!**

**ON ARRIVAL AT TOURNAMENT YOU DO NOT REGISTER.** Please find your section board, ie U8, in the hall, find your name on the board, look across to the number you and your opponent on the board and that is the board number you need to sit down at.
