Time Control

The Weald is a 5-round Swiss tournament.

35 moves in 75 minutes, then add 15 minutes to each clock. A ½ point bye is available in rounds 1 – 4 if requested on the entry form.

Default time is 30 mins after the scheduled start time of the round. Players without an opponent after this time must expect to be re-paired.

Notices

The tournament Controller's decision is final.

Your details will be held on our database solely to inform you about future events.

Results, grades and photos will be published on our website and may be used in the Press.

ECF Standardplay grades (Jan 2013) will be used where possible. ECF Rapidplay grades will be accepted as the player's strength if a player has no ECF Standardplay grade.

Players with estimated grades are not eligible to win a grading prize. If ungraded, please provide an estimate and details of recent results.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving a reason; or to transfer players to a higher section at any point during the event.

Weald Congress Sections

All adults and juniors are welcome – there are no minimum grading or age limits.

The Weald is part of the ECF Grand Prix and results will be submitted to the ECF for grading.

If there are insufficient entries in a section, the organisers may combine sections.
