



How to get to Hazelwood Junior School - N13 5HE

By train the School is an easy walk from Palmers Green Station. It is about half way along Hazelwood Lane on the right hand side.

By bus you should alight in Green Lanes, Palmers Green. From Green Lanes follow Hazelwood Lane as above.

By car approach Hazelwood Lane from Green Lanes or Connaught Gdns. Connaught Gdns is off Hedge Lane (A111) from A10/A406 junction.

SECTIONS

The Congress will be divided into five sections as listed below. All competitors will play in all six rounds. As far as it is possible, people with equal scores will be paired against each other according to the official rules for Swiss Tournaments.

All ages are taken at 31.8.'13.

E.g. The **Under 8** is for competitors who were aged under 8 on 31.8.'13.

Under 18 is for competitors who were aged under 18 on 31.8.'13. This is the upper age limit for Junior Competitors.

Players may enter for the section for which they are qualified or in any higher age group if preferred.

Rate of Play

In all sections players will have thirty minutes to complete all their moves. This ensures that all games are finished in one hour. Players who have not used clocks before will receive instruction in their use before the first round commences.

Grading

All sections will be submitted for ECF Grading

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in each section according to the number of entrants. There will be at least three prizes in each section.

The organisers reserve the right to combine two age groups into one section if, in their opinion, numbers are insufficient for a worthwhile competition.

London Junior Chess Championships

To qualify for the London Junior, competitors in the Under 8 must gain at least 4 points out of their 6 games. In the U10 and U12 sections a score of 3.5 or 4 points qualifies for the Minor and 4.5 or more for the Major.
