Rate of Play. *All moves in 105 minutes.* This rule is subject to re-pairing for late arrivals. Any player arriving more than 30 minutes late will be deemed to have lost unless re-pairing is possible. His/her opponent, however, must expect to be paired again if another player is otherwise without an opponent after 30 minutes. This rule takes precedence over the FIDE 0-minute default rule.

Grading. Grades will be taken from the ECF's August 2011 grading data. (Only players with ECF grades will be eligible for grading prizes.) If you do not have an ECF grade please give any other international grade or provide evidence of your playing strength, e.g. other tournament results. Grading prizes will be shared in the event of a tie. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their grading information being published on the ECF website.

Byes. You may take a half-point bye in any one of the first four rounds. If possible notify us on the entry form or at the beginning of the tournament.

Analysis. Separate accommodation will be available for analysis and discussion.

Withdrawals. If withdrawing during the tournament, please notify a controller or note it on your result slip. If you withdraw before the first round we will refund your entry fee less a **£3.00** administration fee.

Refreshments. Light refreshments will be available on the premises, including tea, coffee, sandwiches, cakes, fruit and chocolate bars.
