

CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS OF THE MIDDLESEX HUNDREDS 2011

This tournament is open to chess players in the county of Middlesex and beyond. Full Championship titles can only be won by players who either, (a) live in the County of Middlesex or (b) go to school in the County of Middlesex. We are using the county boundaries as they were in 1965 (and prior to that), stretching back at least as far as the Domesday Book of 1086. From the map overleaf it can be seen that parts of Barnet are in Hertfordshire, Potters Bar and South Mimms are in Middlesex, as is the southern borough of Spelthorne.

VENUE: Isleworth & Syon School, Ridgeway Road, Isleworth, Middx, TW7 5LJ

Date: SATURDAY, 29th October, 2011

Sections: U7, U8, U9, U10, U11, U12, U14, U18 plus Adult Novice.

Scoring will be 3 point for a win, 2 for a draw and 1 for a loss.

There will be 9 Championship Titles to be won for each separate age group plus individual titles for the Champion of each Hundred within the age groups. The Hundreds are Ossulstone, Edmonton, Gore, Hounslow, Elthorne and Spelthorne. Trophies will be awarded to section champions and certificates to Hundred Champions. In addition, players scoring 11 points or more will win a prize rosette or medal. Players from outside the county who win a section will be awarded a special trophy.

Ages will be calculated as at 01/09/2011.

In the Under 12 and older sections, clocks will be used on all boards, in which case all moves must be completed with 25 minutes each on the clock. In the Under 11 and younger sections, clocks may be used in some sections on the upper boards (not U7s) in which case the rate of play will be 25 moves in 25 minutes.
