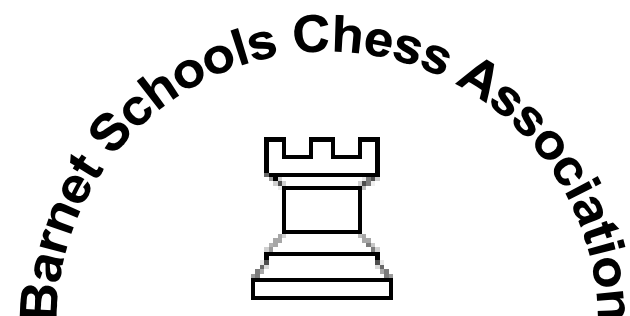

TOURNAMENT DETAILS

Swiss pairings will be used. This is not a knockout tournament. All competitors play in every round. The organisers reserve the right to merge sections in the event of a section receiving insufficient entries.

Chess clocks will be used but help will be given to those who are not used to them. Each player will be allowed 30 minutes per game (making a maximum possible time for each game of 1 hour). ECF Rapidplay rules will be used.

Results will be posted on the Barnet Knights website: www.barnetknights.com and sent for grading. The ECF publishes the Grading list on their website. If you wish to have your Grading details (Grading Reference Number, Name, Club(s), Grade(s), Grading Category) withheld from the website version please contact the ECF, www.englishchess.org.uk.

Parents and friends are welcome to stay, but should note that only stewards and players will be allowed in the playing areas. We do not provide any supervision of children between rounds so you must stay to look after your own children or arrange for another adult to be responsible for your children.

BARNET TEAMS

Barnet Schools Chess Association runs Under 9, Under 11 and Girls Under 11 teams. Players who live or go to school in the London Borough of Barnet or most surrounding London Boroughs are eligible for selection. Last year Barnet Girls were the winners of the National Inter-Association Team Championships. This event will be used by team managers to select the squads.

Certificates and smaller prizes will be presented as competitors finish their last game (5.30pm at the latest). Trophies will be presented at prize-giving, 6.00pm or earlier if possible.

PRIZES

Cash prizes for winners of individual sections. Prize also for winning school performance.

In addition there will be:

- trophy for the top girl in each section.
- prizes for scoring more than 3½ points or more out of 6
- certificate for each competitor
- trophy for top school across all sections

The top Barnet player in each age group will be designated Barnet champion and will hold the appropriate trophy for one year. (A Barnet player is one who lives or goes to school in the London Borough of Barnet.) Players tied for a trophy will be separated by Sum of Progressive scores.

The top Middlesex player in each age group will be designated Middlesex champion and will hold the appropriate trophy for one year. Players tied for a trophy will be separated by Sum of Progressive scores.

The **school prize** will be awarded based on the cumulative scores of the top five players from the same school. In the event of tied scores, the positions from the individual sections will be used as the deciding factor.

The **county prize** will be awarded based on the cumulative scores of the top five players from the same county. In the event of tied scores, the positions from the individual sections will be used as the deciding factor.
