U19 Open National School Chess Championships

Congratulations to RGS Guildford for winning the 2017 National School Chess Championships. They have often been finalists over the past 15 years but this is their first ever championship win. Runners up Hampton School, who also play in Surrey's Briant Poulter Schools' League, are the inaugural winners of the Richard Haddrell Memorial Trophy. Do consider entering the Championships for 2017/18. It is not just for strong teams, indeed they normally gain automatic qualification to the Regional stage in the spring term. This means that the "qualifying events" and leagues in the Autumn term are normally enjoyable for all. Some dates are already fixed and you can find out more on the website.

2017/18 Tournaments

As well as the U19 Championships you can also enter Team Chess Challenge (for teams of 4 players), Junior Team Chess Challenge (4 players in year 8 and below). The girls U19 is for teams of just 3 players. Two events can be mainly run at your chess club, the Problem Solving and Blitz championships.

We already have the date for the National Blitz final (teams of 4): Saturday 17th March 2018 10am to 4pm at The King's School, Grantham. Put it in your diaries, as any school can enter.

Over the summer the website will be updated to launch the new seasons tournaments – I will email when this happens, as that is when you can enter the Championships using the online entry forms.

We do still need some more schools to host events – please do email me if you can help with this.
