This year's U19 open championship has now reached the national stage with 26 school teams left in the competition. You can follow the progress of the teams in these rounds at National Stages.

The one day <u>Last Chance Saloon</u> at Eton College had over 100 players in 18 teams and was won by past National Champions Wellington College.

The two semi-finals for the <u>National Girls' U19</u> <u>championship</u> have been won by Nonsuch School (South) and RGS Newcastle (North). Six team have qualified for the final which will be played during the Easter Holidays.
