ECF Team Chess Challenge

Eleven Schools have already qualified for the national final of Team Chess Challenge by winning their regional final: King Edwards Camp Hill, Eltham College, Urmston Grammar, Nottingham High School, Westminster Under School, Mill Hill County HS, Bangor Grammar School (NI), Millfield School, Manchester GS, Wilson's School and RGS Newcastle.

Three more regional finals take place this term South West (11th Feb), Oxford (12th Feb) and West London (26th Feb). This are afternoon events for



teams of 4 players so they are ideal entry events for schools wanting to start playing inter-school chess. Please do contact your local hosts to enter the event.

ECF National Schools Chess Championship, U19 Open and U19 Girls

We are very grateful to Winchester College (U19 Open) and St Catherine's School, Bramley (U19 Girls') for their continued sponsorship of these tournaments.

The two Girls' <u>U19 Semi-finals</u> took part on Sunday 18th January with 22 teams from 14 schools taking part. Eight teams qualified for the national finals with the winners being Fernwood School (Nottingham) and Howell's School (Cardiff). The other teams qualifying for the finals were RGS Newcastle, St Edwards (Leek), Nonsuch School, (Sutton, A and B teams), The Abbey School (Reading) and Millfield School.

The <u>U19 Open zones</u> are now coming towards completion with zone finals due to be played by February Half term.

If you have been knocked out of your Zone, or not even entered earlier, there are two "<u>Last Chance Saloons</u>" this year offering qualification for the U19 National Stage:

- Saturday 7th February 2015 at Kings School, Grantham
- Sunday 1st March 2015 at Eton College

They are independent events, and a team can qualify from either. They are open to any team that has missed out on qualification from its Zone (that is, has not reached the Zone Final), as well as teams that did not enter at the Zonal stage. A team that enters the first Saloon and fails to qualify may still enter the second. The entry form is at
