At the ECF AGM on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> October the Council voted to allow non-members to play in graded ECF school events. The main consequence of this is that the National Schools Chess Tournaments will not now require ECF membership.

Also, I have returned to my previous position as ECF Secondary School Chess Co-ordinator, and any ECF events I run in future will not be constrained to insist on ECF membership to be graded.
