Number 5 can also cause problems. All of the squares in between the king and rook Ŷ ģ


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Number 3 is tricky - it's fine to castle kingside as it's only the rook that's attacked. And it's fine to castle queenside too - even though the bishop is guarding one of the squares it's not one that the king would pass over, so white wouldn't be castling through check.
