FABIANO CARUANA WINS FIDE Grand Prix - Paris 2013



Fabiano Caruana (ITA, ELO 2779) won FIDE Grand Prix - Paris 2013 with the final result of 7 points out of 11 and better tie-break than Boris Gelfand (ISR, ELO 2764), who finished with the same result. Hikaru Nakamura (USA, ELO-2772) finished third with 6.5 points.

The FIDE Grand Prix was held from 21st

September to 5th October, 2013 in Paris.

The winner of the Grand Prix series is the Bulgarian GM Veselin Topalov (ELO - 2771), while Shakhriyar Mamedyarov (AZE, ELO - 2759) is second. This means that they have both qualified for the Candidates tournament in 2014.
