

GM INDJIC NEW SERBIAN CHAMPION FOR 2014



18-year-old GM Aleksandar Indjic (ELO 2523) won 8th Serbian Individual Chess Championship 2014, which was held in Subotica/Serbia, from 7-17 April. He defeated Ivan Sarenac in the last round and assured the title with 7.5 point out of 11.

This young and talented chess player will be 19 in August this year, and already has many impressing results behind him. By winning the Serbian Championship, he managed to add a prestigious National Champion title to his collection as well.





Silver medal went to GM Milos Perunovic (ELO 2631) with 7 points, and bronze medal went to GM Nikola Sedlak (ELO 2568) with 6.5 points.

The tournament was played as a Round Robin one, with 12 participants in 11 rounds. The time control was 90 minutes for 40 moves, followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game + 30 seconds increment per move, starting from move one.

The Championship was organized by Serbian Chess Federation and Chess Federation of Vojvodina.

GM ALLAN STIG RASMUSSEN WINS THE DANISH NATIONAL CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP



GM Allan Stig Rasmussen won the Danish National Chess Championship with the final result of 7 points out of 9. Silver went to GM Sune Berg Hansen with 6 points, while GM Jacob Aagaard and IM Jacob Vang Glud finished in the shared 3-4th place with 5.5 points.

This the third national title for GM Allan Rasmussen – he was Danish champion in 2010 and 2011.

The Armenian Youth Chess Championships for boys and girls – U 10, 12, 14, 16, 18 was held from 13-22 April, 2014 in Yerevan.

Chief Arbiter of the championships, organized by the Armenian Chess Federation, was IA Armen Nikoghosyan, while Tournament Director was GM Smbat Lputian. One hundred and eight young chess players competed for the title in their categories.
