- 90 minutes per game plus bonus 30 seconds for each move.

XII. ACCOMMODATION, BOARD AND TRANSPORT

- Transport: Ružomberok is central crossing in Slovakia. You can get to Ružomberok by train, bus or car. The hotel is situated 600 meters from the railway station. XIII. COSTS OF ACCOMMODATION, BOARD, ENTRY FEE AND TRANSPORT

Payment for participation in the tournament involves: accommodation, full-board, snacks, final banquet, entry fee, local fee, gifts and cultural program, SPA, chess simultaneous:

- For chess players in „A” and „B” tournament – **490 EUR** per person,
- For attendants of disabled players and accompanying persons – **440 EUR** per person,
- Additional payment for the extra days is **40 EUR** per person for day,
- Additional payment for single room is **10 EUR** for night,
- Transport of participants from the airport and back: Krakow – **60 EUR** per person, Budapest – **90 EUR** per person, Bratislava – **90 EUR** per person.

The participation costs should be paid to the bank account of the organizer not later than 25th April 2017. In some cases there will be possible a payment in cash in the arrival day.

XV. FINAL INFORMATION

- The 17th IPCA World Individual Chess Championship 2017 will be played according to the current FIDE rules in force since 01.10.2014.
- The player who arrives at the round (at chess table) with a delay of more than 30 minutes after the start of the round, loses the game.
- The organizer has the right to interpret of the Regulations, and all matters relating with the play rules are in jurisdiction of chief arbiter.
- The decisions of the chief arbiter during the competition are final.
- In all matters not included in that communication decides the organizer of tournament.
- For the capacity of the player to participation in the tournament, as well as for his insurance are responsible delegating organizations.
- **The representatives of the IPCA National Federations who have got a mandate to represent their countries will participate in the 24th IPCA Congress in Ružomberok on 1st June 2017.**
