All entries must be accompanied by the correct entry fee, which is £20, with a £7.50 discount to members of Richmond Junior Chess Club or one of its affiliated schools, and a £5.00 discount to other juniors.

All players must be members of the English Chess Federation, at Silver level or better. If you are not a member then, at the discretion of the organisers, a £10.50 surcharge is payable, to cover the ECF grading charge.
