Prizes

The prize money is guaranteed if entries reach 140. Junior prizes will be awarded in the Minor section and additional grading prizes in the other sections if finances permit. Players without an ECF or FIDE grade will not be eligible for grading prizes and a deduction of 50% will be made on any cash prize won by such a player.

The top three finishers in each section will also win Diamond membership at chess.com.

Deadline for Entries

Entries close at 8pm on Friday 19th October to allow organisers to make final arrangements.

Withdrawals

Refunds will be provided at the organisers' discretion, but not for players who fail to turn up.

Grading

All games played in this congress will be submitted to the ECF for grading.

Late Arrivals

Players arriving more than 30 minutes after the scheduled round start time will be defaulted. Players without opponents should expect to be re-paired 30 minutes after the start of a round.

Byes

A bye may be taken in any of rounds 1 to 4, provided this is requested with entry. However, a bye in round 3 can also be requested on the Saturday of the event provided this is done before 17:00.

Website

Entrants' names and grades, along with pairings and results will be displayed on the Congress website.

Accommodation

Refreshments

Light refreshments will be available throughout the weekend.

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones must be switched off in the playing area, and must not be on a player's person at any time during their game. Any player whose mobile phone makes any sound during play, or who is found to be using or consulting any device capable of suggesting chess moves, will be immediately defaulted that game.
