#### **Tournament Regulations**

Early Bird discounts of £3 are available for players entering before Oct. 26, while the closing date for entries is Dec. 2. Entries after this date will be subject to a late fee of £3. For the FIDE-rated Open, England players should be ECF Gold members, or should add an extra 'pay-to-play' fee of £10.50 to their entry fee. No player may normally win more than one prize. All prize money is shared equally if a tie occurs. One half-point bye may be requested in advance for Rounds 1-4.
