

## Base Voting Register for the ECF Council, 2018-2019

### Explanatory Notes

This is the base register to be used for ECF Council Meeting during the year October 2018 to September 2019. Only ECF Council members whose vote depends, or may depend, on graded games submitted are included in this list. Other members of Council will appear on the meeting specific registers published in the run up to each Council meeting. These will also include details of appointed proxies, which apply for one meeting only.

The number of votes is determined by the number of “half games” submitted for grading and one vote is given for each thousand half games, always rounded upwards. Both standard and rapidplay games are included but rapidplay games are counted at half value.

The register is based on games played during the grading year July 2017 to June 2018 using the August revision of that grading period. Some adjustments have been made for events overlapping grading years to prevent double counting or total omission of these events.

Organisations may change their representative at any time and that will be reflected in this document as such notifications arrive. However, such notifications received very close to the date of a Council meeting may not be actioned in time to take effect. Details of deadlines are notified when Council meeting documentation is sent out.

Organisations that are not represented on Council but which have submitted games for grading are entitled to allocate their total of submitted games to any of the organisations listed in this document. Once a choice has been made this will remain in place for all future years until countermanded. Organisations wishing to make such allocations should write to the Voting Registration Officer at [vro@englishchess.org.uk](mailto:vro@englishchess.org.uk) stating the name of their organisation, to whom they wish to allocate their games for voting purposes and the Emails should be signed (type only is satisfactory) by an official of the organisation who should affirm that he/she has authority to make the allocation and state their role in the organisation. This allocation may be made at any time and the votes listed here will alter to reflect such allocations. Allocations received less than a week prior to a Council Meeting may not take effect in time for that meeting.

For the convenience of members this register is published alongside a second document that lists the events both of the member and of organisations that have allocated their games to that member. Inevitably mistakes and misallocations do sometimes occur and members are asked to check this document so that such errors can be corrected.

As the voting register officer I am always ready to give any guidance and assistance that may be necessary.
