SECTIONS

There are 3 sections, Under 11, Under 9 and Under 7.

You must have been younger than the section age on 31st August 2018. So, Under 11 means a Year 6 or younger and Under 9 means a Year 4 or younger, Under 7 means Year 2 or younger.

PARKING

Please note there is no parking at the venue. There is limited pay and display outside which is quite expensive so we suggest you travel by public transport. Those with a Kensington and Chelsea parking permit will be able to park on the surrounding streets.

All games will be submitted to the ECF for grading.

PRIZES

Trophies for first, second and third in each section. Players tied for a trophy will be separated by Sum of Progressive scores. There will also be prizes for all players scoring over 50%. All players will receive a certificate of achievement.

This is not a knockout tournament. All competitors play in every round. Swiss pairings will be used.

RATE OF PLAY

Fischer time control - 20 mins plus 5 secs a move. A brief explanation for those not familiar with chess clocks will be given at the beginning of the competition.

Parents and friends are welcome to stay, but should note that only stewards and players will be allowed in the playing areas. We do not provide any supervision of children between rounds so you must stay to look after your own children or arrange for another adult to be responsible for your children.
