Born in South London, eight-time British women's champion, (the last time at the British Championships held in Hull in 2018) Jovanka Houska became an International Master in 2005, lured by the thrill of checkmate she has since then devoted herself to chess! She has represented England in 18 team championships, winning a silver medal for her performance on board one in Iceland, 2015. In 2006 she became the first woman to win the prestigious English Player of the year title after her participation in the Women's World Championship. Jovanka has written three chess books and in 2016 co-authored a romantic novel set in the chess world called "The Mating Game." When she is not playing, writing or commentating on chess; you will probably find her on a plane somewhere above the North Sea splitting her time between her homes in Bergen and the UK.
