




Don't Stress! Play Chess! Freshers, Socials & Football.

This year, we set up our first 5-a-side Football Team, which play in the University 5-a-side Sunday League! We even came 4th, in the Winter Season, beating established societies, such as Engineering!



Competitive Chess & The 2nd Warwick Rapidplay! (ECF & FIDE-rated)

We have many opportunities for our members to play competitive chess, as the largest University Chess society across the UK. We run 5 weekly teams in the local Coventry & District Chess League, over 3 Divisions, as well as 3 teams to the 2020 National Rapiplay League, and a record 9 Teams to the British Universities Chess (BUCA) Team Championships. We won BUCA in 2018 and 2017; this year, we came 4th, qualifying tor the 2019 European Championships - winning 3 Team prizes, and 16 Board prizes.

This year, we had a record 74 players at the 2nd Warwick University Rapidplay - with players from far and wide. We even got the top boards of the Open Section onto live boards - a first for us.









Trips to Birmingham & Coventry!

To give our players more competitive chess opportunities, we run trips to local Rapidplays, in the 25th Birmingham Rapidplay, and the Coventry & District Chess League Centenary Rapidplay 2019. For the Coventry Centenary, we brought one minibus of players to play; whilst at the Birmingham Rapidplay, we

brought a minibus and two car-loads of 27 players!





Warwick Chess in Schools!

The Society prides itself in its outreach work and links with the local community, we strongly encourage our members to go into schools and academies to coach chess. Some of our members volunteer with the local Coventry Chess Academy, a leading chess academy in the Midlands. Many of our volunteers are part of the Warwick Chess in Schools Programme, a Warwick Volunteers-funded programme to bring chess into local schools in underprivileged areas of Coventry. Currently we have session on Wednesdays and Fridays, at

Grange Farm Primary, and Templars Primary.
