Junior Coaching

Immediately prior to the start of the congress, and running concurrently with the early rounds of the GM Norm event, there will be three days of junior coaching, led by FM Charlie Storey, assisted by Joanne Hutchinson of the Hull and District Chess Association. Timetable (there will be refreshment and lunch breaks each day (not included):

- Wednesday October 30th 14.30 – 18.30 Expert Opening training, including looking and learning from live GM Norm Games.
- Thursday October 31st 09.30 – 16.00. Expert Middlegame training, including looking and learning from live GM Norm Games.
- Friday November 1st 09.30 – 16.00 Expert Endgame training, including looking and learning from live GM Norm Games

Numbers for the coaching will be limited, and preference will be given to juniors playing in the weekend congress. There is no lower age limit (although participants in the coaching must be juniors) but the coaching will not be suitable for juniors graded less than 100 (whether or not playing in the congress). You may book for one, two or three days. For those registering before 1st October, there will be an opportunity to influence the content. An attendance register will operate each day.

Non local participants will be required to be resident at the venue - accommodation may be booked at the congress rate (see congress entry form) – please indicate your requirement at the time of booking for the coaching (see below).

There is no charge for the coaching. HDCA and 4NCL are grateful to the John Robinson Youth Chess Trust for a grant to enable this coaching to take place free of charge.
