

Grading

Rapidplay grades will be used where available; otherwise long play grades will be used. Ungraded players will be assigned an estimate by the Controller. All results will be submitted to the ECF for their Rapidplay grading list.

Clocks

Digital clocks will be used in both sections with a time limit of 20 minutes per player plus 10 seconds for each move.

Prizes

The winners of each section will receive prize money. Other prizes will be awarded, and prizes may be increased dependent on entry and at the Controller's discretion. Subject to entry, junior prizes will be awarded in the U100 section. The highest placed Norfolk player will hold the Peter Burnett Cup for one year.

Prize winners may elect to receive their prize money through either cheque or bank transfer.

Sections

Sections are dependent on entry and the Controller reserves the right to merge sections. Where a higher fee may have been payable the transfer will be at no extra cost.

Refreshments

Tea Coffee and biscuits will be available. There are no food facilities at the venue but there are pubs and food outlets a short distance from the venue. You can bring your own food.

Byes and election to play in the championship

Players may request a half point bye in the 1st round with their entry. Players may elect to play in the Championship section if not eligible by grade.
