

How to Enter

(i) **Online** via our website <https://www.kidlingtonchess.org.uk/>.

After completing the online entry form under the *Kidlington 2020* tab, click the *Submit* button at the bottom to be transferred to the PayPal website to make your payment. **OR:**

(ii) Fill in a copy of this entry form and send it with your cheque (payable to 'The Kidlington Chess Tournament') to: Gerard O'Reilly, 24 Donnington Bridge Road, Oxford OX4 4AX.

We reserve the right to refuse entries or to transfer entrants between sections at any point.

Rules & conditions: The tournament will operate in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess unless otherwise announced, e.g. on this entry form or on the [Kidlington Tournament website](#). For more details see the website. Players entering the tournament **agree thereby to abide by the decisions of the controllers.**

Electronic devices: A player **must not use any electronic device during a game** without the controller's explicit permission. Players may keep such devices with them at the venue, but they must be fully switched off (not merely muted) in the playing area *at all times during playing sessions*. In particular, a player whose **mobile phone** sounds during a game will forfeit the game.

Individual and Team Prizes. No entrant may receive more than one individual prize, but a winner of an individual prize remains eligible for a share in the team competition prize.

Free Entry — Teams of 4 players nominated from any sections — Prize £40.00

Rate of Play: All moves in **90 minutes, plus 15 seconds per move increment from move 1.** Any player arriving more than 30 minutes late will be deemed to have lost unless re-pairing is possible. His or her opponent, however, must expect to be paired again if another player is otherwise without a game after 30 minutes. *The rate of play is subject to alteration in the case of such re-pairings.*

Byes: You may take a half-point bye in any *one* of the first four rounds. Please notify us if possible on the entry form or at the beginning of the tournament.

Withdrawals: If withdrawing during the tournament, please notify a controller in person or note it on your result slip. If you withdraw before 9pm on Thursday 30 January we will refund your entry fee less a **£5** administration fee.

Grading and prizes: Grades will be taken, where available, from the latest revision of the ECF's August 2019 grading list, based on results up to 30 June 2019. If you have no current ECF grade, please give your most recent ECF grade and any other current official grade. If you have none, please provide other evidence of your playing strength, e.g. tournament results.

Please note that:

(i) In the grading-limited sections, players for whom we lack grading information based on at least 10 graded games in the last 5 years can receive only half of *any* individual prize.

(ii) Only players with a current ECF standard-play grade are eligible for grading prizes.

Grading prizes will be shared in the event of a tie.

Please also note that it is a condition of entry that players agree to their grading information and results being published on the ECF grading website, the [Kidlington Tournament website](#), and the [Chess-Results.com](#) website.

Analysis: A separate room will be available for analysis and discussion.

ECF membership: Silver-or-higher-level members of the ECF will have their Kidlington games graded free of charge, but the ECF charges tournament organizers £9 for the grading of the games of non-members and Bronze-level members. Hence the grading surcharge for such entrants on our entry form. Bronze-level ECF members who pay the surcharge will have their membership upgraded to Silver level after the tournament.

Change of Tournament Software: We have switched from our former tournament management software and will be using Swiss-Manager for pairings, posting results online, etc.
