- Fide Rapidplay rating will be converted into ECF Grade.
- Standard ECF grade or converted FIDE rating will be taken in the absence of ECF rapid grade.
- A player without any grade or rating can enter with an estimated grading of 80.
- The ECF and FIDE database will be used to scrutinise participants' grading/rating.
- BBCA reserves the right to refuse an entry, without assigning a reason, and cancel or merge two sections for lack of adequate participants.



- BBCA reserves the right to modify the format and prizes if required.
- DISPUTES: In all matters the Arbiter's decision will be final.
