ECF Online continues to be very popular with 6 ECF online rated members club events on chess.com and lichess running each week. These are a mix of 90 minute rapid and blitz tournaments and are now very well subscribed.

Internationals - We also played in a number of International Events during the month on lichess including:

- The December lichess Nations Cup on 05/12 We finished third in our group behind Armenia and France and just missed qualifying for the December final. We will be back next month.

ECF Online Club Memberships have continued to increase with more than 1,100 players in the chess.com members club and over 900 in the lichess English Chess Players Club. The November list was issued during the month with around 4,500 players with online ratings from ECF club and affiliated events.

Daily Chess - Our Daily Chess programme continues to develop with Manager of Daily Chess Andrew Caswell scheduling a series of Daily Chess Championships for 2021 for members of the ECF member club. Team England have also beaten the Russian Team in the World League finals in a 665 board match with a report from Andy in the Newsletter below.



Caplin British Chess Championships Online – The main Online Event for December will be the British Online which will take place over 2 weeks from 18 December 2020 to 3 January 2021 on the chess.com platform. This will be the first British Online Championships in 106 years since the tournament started in 1904 and means the British continues in a different format without a gap (the previous one being during the war years).

Entry levels are looking very good with two weeks to go. We are hoping the BCC Online will provide members with an opportunity to play in a competitive National Event over the holiday period and will be part of a wider series of online events.

We are running the main British Online Championships with separate Women's, Seniors (50+ and 65+) and Juniors (U18, U16, U14, U12, U10 and U8). Each Championship will include separate Events at Standardplay and Rapid time controls, and a number of Championships also include Blitz and Bullet time controls.

The winners of the finals will become the British Online Champions in the relevant categories. The prize fund includes trophies and various items of merchandise.

Player Ratings and Titles

The ECF Master Points system and National Title qualifications have been relaunched to be based on 4 digit ratings rather than 3 digit grades together with performance across the monthly lists. You can find full details here:
