## PRIZES

All sections; 1st £150, 2nd £100, 3rd £70, 2 Grading Prizes £40 and a trophy winners prize £40. Ungraded players will only be eligible to win 3rd prize in the Championship, no other prizes.

£20 for all sections to ECF members silver and above.

ECF Bronze members and non ECF members must pay an additional 'pay to play' fee of £9.

Discount for Juniors (under 18 on 31st August 2021) may deduct £5.
