The ECF Aug 2022 rating list will be used for entries but the September list for pairing and rating.

In tournaments other than the Open, players with estimated ratings may not be eligible for the main prizes and are not eligible for Rating prizes in any section.

Junior - means under 18 on 1st January 2022

Senior— player born before 1st January 1957

North East Player - is a player based in: Northumberland, Durham, Tyneside or Cleveland.

Northumberland Junior - is a player who plays for a club or team registered with the Northumberland Chess Association, or who lives in Northumberland or Tyneside.
