







WGM / WIM Women's Norm Event The 8th Menchik Memorial



Vera Menchik (1906-44) was the first women's world chess champion, as well as the longest reigning champion, gaining the title at 21 and defending it multiple times until her untimely death.

Although born in Russia to a Czech father and English mother, Vera Menchik lived in England from the age of 15 and became the strongest female player of the era whilst living in Hastings and London.

This year marks the 80th anniversary of Menchik's death, caused by a German V1 rocket which landed near her home in Clapham.

The tournament is being staged by Chess Promotions Ltd and funded by the English Chess Federation with a grant from the **Department of Culture Media and Sport (DCMS)**.
