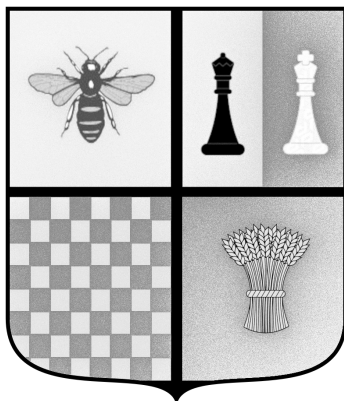

Open: 1st £250, 2nd £125 & 3rd £75

U1800: 1st £200, 2nd £100 & 3rd £50

U1400: 1st £200, 2nd £100 & 3rd £50

Those without an ECF or FIDE rating can win a maximum of £50 except in the Open and are not eligible for grading prizes

## **ENTRY FEE:**

**OPEN: £25 per person for Platinum and Gold ECF Members.**

**U1800 and U1400: £20 per person for Platinum and Gold ECF Members.**

**There will be an extra £15 fee for Bronze or non-ECF members.**

**Please include full name in the payment reference for easy identification.**

Entry can only be effected by payment of the appropriate fee. The closing date is **WEDNESDAY 18 JUNE 2025**. Entries received after this date will be subject to a £5 late fee. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Each player has 20 minutes time for the game plus 5 seconds increment for each move. International Chess Federation (FIDE) RapidPlay rules apply and these will be displayed.

This is not a knockout competition. Players take part in all rounds and will be matched against an opponent with a score similar to their own (the “Swiss System”). Competitors must notify the Event Director if they wish to withdraw during the event. Not to do so is discourteous to the next opponent.

Mobile phone ringers **MUST** be switched off during play.

## ABOUT FRODSHAM

Frodsham is a market town in the north of Cheshire. It is situated around 16 miles south of Liverpool and 28 miles west of Manchester. Frodsham Station is served by regular rail services on the Chester to Manchester line and Frodsham Community Centre is around 2 miles from Junction 12 of the M56.
